



Erasmus incoming: Useful information

Courses

You're welcoming at IPC for an Erasmus mobility in our bachelor (BA) in Philosophy or in Psychology. **The required French language is B2**. The great majority of our classes are in French. **French tutoring is possible**; please go to the international office or send a mail to Erasmus@ipc-paris.fr for this.

At IPC, the majority of professors come from other universities, thus the timetable changes everyweek depending on the timetable of each professor. Timetables are updated every Wednesday evening for the following week. Changes can appear daily, so please consult the timetable on a regular basis.

Students are asked to take 30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) for one semester.

You have 2 weeks after your arrival at IPC to go and test as many classes as you want. <u>Attendance in class is mandatory</u>. Non-attendance has to be justified (medical certificate for example).

Exams

An exam session is scheduled at the end of each semester. The exams timetable is sent 2 weeks before the start of the exams period.

At IPC, exams may be written, oral or a continuous assessment; please check with your Erasmus referent how you will be evaluated.
