<b>DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION PROCESSES</b>	<p><b>Nomination period:</b> 1st March - 30th April</p> <p><b>Student's application deadline:</b> 15th June</p> <p><b><u>Important notes:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nominations are collected <b>once a year for both semesters</b>.</li><li>• We accept nominations <b>for only one semester</b> - upon the student's request, it is possible to apply for an extension for an additional semester by submitting an application during the mobility.</li><li>• <b>Submission of a nomination does not guarantee acceptance of the candidate</b>, as the number of places is limited.</li><li>• If the limit of places for Bachelor psychology programme in a given city is reached, students will be offered places at another campus, depending on availability.</li><li>• Additional information will be provided to candidates at the beginning of May.</li></ul>

<b>MEDICAL INSURANCE</b>	<p>All international students must obtain medical insurance for the duration of their study in Poland and must provide SWPS University with a proof of a medical insurance policy. <b>VISA, RESIDENCE CARD, LEGAL SUPPORT</b>	<p>Non-European students applying for regular or exchange programmes as well as Global MINDS programme must apply for a <b>Visa</b> and/or a <b>Residence Card</b>. To obtain a visa, you should contact a Polish Embassy or a Consulate in your country of origin.</p> <p>Please request the acceptance letter, if you need one.
